BBE: end of September 2025



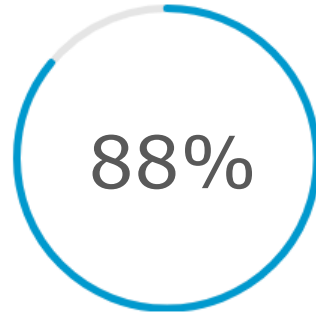

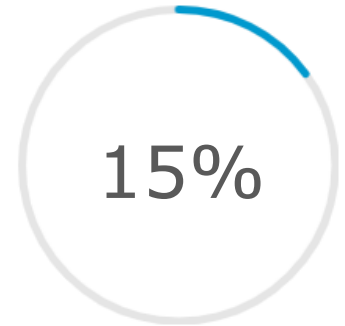


Hard Work in the First Year Pays Off!

Only about 12 out of 100 students drop out, 88 successfully complete their studies!
